

**LOCAL RULE 9029**  
**General Provisions**

(a) *Prior Rules Superseded* - These Local Rules of Practice for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan provide standardized procedures for the convenience of the bench and bar. They supersede all previous local rules and general orders.

(b) *General Orders* - Should any matter of practice or procedure require the attention of the Court prior to amendment of these Rules, the Court may enter a general order which will have the same force and effect as the Local Rules. The Clerk shall maintain a file of such general orders entered by the Court and shall date and number them chronologically. General orders shall be posted for public inspection in the office of the Clerk and on the Court's Internet Web site at <http://www.miw.uscourts.gov>.

(c) *Technical Corrections* - Technical corrections to these Rules may be made by the Court at any time and notice of such will be provided on the Court's Internet Web site at <http://www.miw.uscourts.gov> and posted in the Clerk's office.

(d) *Suspension or Modification* - Any judge of this Court may suspend or modify a requirement or provision of any of these Local Rules in a particular case, adversary proceeding, or contested matter on the Court's own motion or on motion of a party.
