**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SHORTEN NOTICE
REGARDING MOTION FOR [TITLE OF MOTION]**

This matter comes before the court on the [TITLE OF MOTION] [Dkt. No. ____] (the “Motion to Shorten”) filed by [NAME OF MOVANT] (the “Movant”), on behalf of [NAME OF DEBTOR/CREDITOR/TRUSTEE]. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event no objections are timely filed, the Movant may file a certificate of no objection, in which case the court may enter an order approving the relief sought without the need for a hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Movant shall serve a copy of this Order, the Motion and all documents related thereto upon requisite parties via first class mail by no later than [DATE].
