Upon consultation with the other bankruptcy judges in this district, it has been determined that it is appropriate to enter this Administrative Order which closes the bankruptcy court on June 11, 2004 and extends the time to timely file a pleading or paper until the next business day, as contemplated by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Clerk's Office for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan, Southern and Northern Divisions, shall be officially closed on Friday, June 11, 2004. Court hearings previously scheduled shall be held or adjourned at the discretion of the judge.
- 2. In the event that Friday, June 11, 2004 is the last day of a designated period to file a pleading or other paper, the time to timely file such pleading or paper is hereby extended to Monday, June 14, 2004, the next business day that the court is officially open, in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006.
