**ORDER AMENDING
ELECTRONIC CASE FILING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES
TO CONFORM TO REVISED FED. R. BANKR. P. 9006(f)**


In view of the amendment to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(f) that will become effective on December 1, 2016, the Court has determined to amend its Electronic Case Filing Administrative Procedures to provide that the three-day extension of time to act that applies under the current version of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(f) shall not apply when service is made through the Court's Electronic Case Filing System.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective on December 1, 2016, Electronic Case Filing Administrative Procedures ¶ II.B.2 is amended to read as follows:

2. The Filing User must serve pleadings or documents upon all persons entitled to notice or service in accordance with applicable rules. If the recipient is a registered participant in the System, service of the "Notice of Electronic Filing" shall be the equivalent of service of the pleading or other paper (other than a summons and complaint) by first class mail, postage prepaid, provided, however, that the three-day extension prescribed in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(f) shall not apply when service is made through the System.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall promptly prepare and publish on the Court's website, and otherwise make available, a revised version of the Electronic Case Filing Administrative Procedures reflecting this amendment.
