### MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO SELL THE ESTATE'S INTEREST IN JUDGMENT

**NOW COMES** Stephen L. Langeland, Trustee, moves for a sale of real property of the estate pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §363 as follows:

- 1. He is the duly appointed and acting Chapter 7 Trustee in this case filed under Chapter 7 on December 20, 2012.
