DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH (MUSKEGON, CADILLAC, etc.)

U.S. 131 south. Exit Leonard Street (Turner Ave.)
Proceed through the light at the intersection of Leonard St. and Turner (you are traveling south on Turner) go to the first stop sign at Sixth St Turn right (west) go one block to Broadway. Turn right (north).
New Vintage will be one block up on the left. Look for the Smokestack.

FROM THE EAST (LANSING, CASCADE, etc.)

Take I 96 to 196 and exit at Ottawa Ave. (Downtown). Turn right (west) at the first light onto Michigan St and proceed over the River. Michigan St. turns into Bridge St over the Bridge.

Go three traffic lights (keeping in the right lane) to Broadway Ave. Turn Right (north) and go up to Eighth Street. New Vintage will be on the left. Look for the Smokestack.

FROM THE SOUTH (KALAMAZOO et al.)

U.S. 131 North to Pearl Street Exit. Proceed through the intersection (you are on Scribner). Travel north to the first light (Bridge St) and turn left (west), keeping to the right lane. Proceed through the light and go one block to the next light (Broadway) and turn right (north). Go to Eighth Street New Vintage will be on the left. Look for the Smokestack.

FROM THE WEST (HOLLAND et al)

I 196 to the Kalamazoo Exit for U.S. 131. Stay in the lane and immediately exit onto Pearl Street. At the traffic light turn left (east). Under the viaduct turn left (north onto Scribner). Proceed to the next traffic light (Bridge Street) and turn left (west), keeping to the right lane. Proceed through the intersection and go to the next light (Broadway Ave) and turn right (north). Go up to Eighth Street, New Vintage will be on the left. Look for the Smokestack.
