P. 9029(a) and the spirit of the Rules Enabling Act, 28 U.S.C. §2075. The purpose of any proposed revisions will not be to rewrite Bankruptcy Code provisions, Federal Rules, or court decisions with which members of the bar may disagree. The Committee's task will be to revise and propose rules to govern procedures not already addressed in the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. The tradition in this District is to have relatively few Local Rules and rely on the Federal Rules to govern practice in our Court.

Every document has room for improvement and that includes our Local Rules. Their clarity, wisdom, and fidelity to law are essential to our collective ability to help those who turn to our Court for assistance. I look forward to your help in forming a productive and balanced Committee.
