I. Introduction

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan seek to update 10 year old audio sound & control system to digital audio & control systems in two courtrooms (Court B & C).

II. Scope of Work

Courtrooms B & C will have the existing AMX controlled audio sound system updated to a Crestron controlled digital sound system. The control display monitor shall be no less than 15 inches, touch and tilt screen capable. The new control system shall allow remote web browser access and control of audio systems. All microphones (7 gooseneck cardioid condenser microphones with stands, 1 gooseneck cardioid condenser microphones without stand, and 1 boundary) and XLR floor connectors will be replaced. Four exterior rooms (per courtroom) that receive audio feeds from the sound system will have wall mount volume control knob replace with new volume control knobs with level indicators. The pre-existing Document Camera, Video Cameras, Polycom Video Conference system (NS4000) & all display monitors must be integrated into the new Crestron control system. The new system must allow for both analog and voip telephony interfaces non-concurrently, as well as output to digital recording (DCR) and Barix Audio Streaming systems. There is also one wireless microphone and one interpreter mic/headset input/output connection per courtroom.

Vendor shall provide Buyer with a copy of the End User license agreement, and shall warrant that all software is licensed originally to Buyer as the original licensee authorized to use the software.

VII. Service Requirements

A. Provide access to technical assistance center personnel who can assist in the diagnosis and resolution of problems with toll free telephonic availability 24 hours per day, 365 days a year. Include ability to allow United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan the ability to open trouble tickets online, via email, or telephone.

B. Provide for availability to operating system upgrades for equipment, patches, and bug fixes as them are released. Include updates and software releases and any supporting documentation online and/or hardcopy.

C. Provide for advanced parts replacement of defective equipment. A part replacement program to include advanced replacement of parts based on contracted support levels, i.e Next Business Day or 4 hour response.

D. Provide access to online resources, tools, including knowledge bases, troubleshooting tools, and technology information.
