I. Introduction

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan seek to update a 10 year old plus audio sound & control system to digital audio & control system in Lansing & Kalamazoo, MI courtrooms.

II. Scope of Work

Both Lansing & Kalamazoo courtrooms will have their existing AMX controlled audio sound system updated to a Crestron controlled digital sound system. The control display monitor shall be no less than 10 inches, touch and tilt screen capable. The new control system shall allow remote web browser access and control of audio systems. All existing microphones (7 gooseneck cardioid condenser microphones with stands, 1 gooseneck cardioid condenser microphones without stand, and 1 boundary) should have individual volume control and mute for overall courtroom sound and also for the recording output to the Digital Recording PC. Two exterior rooms and 1 Barix audio streaming device that receive audio feeds from the sound system will have an individual mutton button in addition to the mute all button. The new system must allow for VOIP telephony interface, as well as USB 8 channel output to the Digital Recording PC (DCR). Note there is one wireless microphone, one interpreter mic/headset input/output device, one Barix Audio Streaming device, and two RF Listening Assistance transmitters per courtroom. Additionally, there needs to be two new headset (3.5mm stereo TRS) connectors at the DCR station; 1 with a feed directly from the sound system and 1 from a PC headset port in the A/V room next to the sound system rack. A third 3.5mm TS connector providing line level audio directly from the sound system is also needed at the DCR Station in the courtroom. There is currently no video at either courtroom, but this new system should be expandable to allow for future video presentation.

Vendor shall provide Buyer with a copy of the End User license agreement, and shall warrant that all software is licensed originally to Buyer as the original licensee authorized to use the software.

VII. Service Requirements

A. Provide access to technical assistance center personnel who can assist in the diagnosis and resolution of problems with toll free telephonic availability 24 hours per day, 365 days a year. Include ability to allow United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan the ability to open trouble tickets online, via email, or telephone.

B. Provide for availability to operating system upgrades for equipment, patches, and bug fixes as them are released. Include updates and software releases and any supporting documentation online and/or hardcopy.

C. Provide for advanced parts replacement of defective equipment. A part replacement program to include advanced replacement of parts based on contracted support levels, i.e Next Business Day or 4 hour response.
