<b>Expedited Transcript (7-Day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order	4.85	.90	.60
<b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day	6.05	1.20	.90
<b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours	7.25	1.20	.90
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment	3.05	n/a	n/a
