
CLOSING OF CLERK'S OFFICE OF

The discovery of a "white powder" in the building compelled closing of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan on Friday, August 31, 2012 at approximately 10:00 a.m. Until an investigation was completed, a health risk existed and it was determined to be prudent to close the court until it was determined the building was safe. The court has determined that the entry of this order is necessary and proper.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. In the event that Friday, August 31, 2012, was the last day of a designated period to file a pleading or other paper, the time to timely file such pleading or paper is hereby extended to Tuesday, September 4, 2012, the next business day that the court is officially open, in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006.
