The application of LBR 3016(c) may be inconsistent with the governing statute and the iming of the collection of the trustees' fee. Compare LBR 3016(c) (authorizing chapter 13 trustee to collect fee "at the time of distribution to the creditor") with 28 U.S.C. § 586(e)(2) (chapter 13 trustee "shall collect such percentage fee from all payments received by such (trustee) under plans"). To avoid inconsistency and uncertainty, the Court has determined to defer to the statute by suspending the local rule. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9029 (requiring local pankruptcy rules to be consistent with Acts of Congress).	
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective as of September 10, 2014, LBR 3016(c) is SUSPENDED and without effect, pending further order of the Court.
