
CLERK'S AUTHORITY TO ADDRESS

Administrative Order No. 2005-2


On July 14, 2004, by Administrative Order 2004-06, this Court established mandatory electronic case filing effective January 1, 2005. Exceptions to electronic case filing were established in that order which included, among others, the ability of an attorney to file a Motion for Leave to File Conventionally under unique circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court and the Clerk's deputies are authorized to issue orders which address instances where pleadings are filed conventionally.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any party may seek review of the actions of the Clerk in a particular case upon motion filed for good cause shown.


