Administrative Order

The Court recognizes that conversion to Case Management/Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) is a complex undertaking that will be prone to occasional administrative errors. Accordingly, the Court wishes to vest the Clerk of the Court and the Clerk's deputies with the authority to correct docketing errors now and in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court and the Clerk's deputies are authorized to correct administrative docketing errors, including but not limited to reopening of incorrectly closed cases, setting aside of incorrectly entered discharges, etc., until further order of this Court. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any party may seek a review of the actions of the Clerk in a particular case upon motion filed for good cause shown.
