
The court takes notice that the electronic case management and filing system, CM/ECF, will be unavailable to the public from 12:00 a.m. on October 17, 2005, until the completion of a system upgrade (version 2.7) to implement the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The court finds that pursuant to Bankr.R.Fed.P. 9006, good cause exists to order that in the event Monday, October 17, 2005, is the last day of a designated period to file a pleading or other paper, the time to file such pleading or paper is hereby extended until 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, October 18, 2005, that being the next business day which the court is officially open;

2. Emergency paper bankruptcy petitions will be accepted by the Clerk from walk-in (only) requested court e-filers, only if a specific written statement outlines the facts requiring an emergency filing on October 17, 2005, and accompanies the petition.
